

Boca Raton II Tri-Rail Station Project Development & Environment Study

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study to evaluate alternatives for a second Tri-Rail station within the South Florida Rail Corridor in the City of Boca Raton between just north of Glades Road and south of Palmetto Park Road. The proposed station may include a surface parking lot, drop-off area, walkway to the station and various station amenities. Several alternatives developed during a previous feasibility study and the option to not build a station will be considered.



PROJECT GOALS

- » Serve underutilized travel markets of Downtown Boca Raton, colleges and universities, and area businesses (i.e. Boca Town Center) and residents.
- » Improve accessibility to the Tri-Rail system.

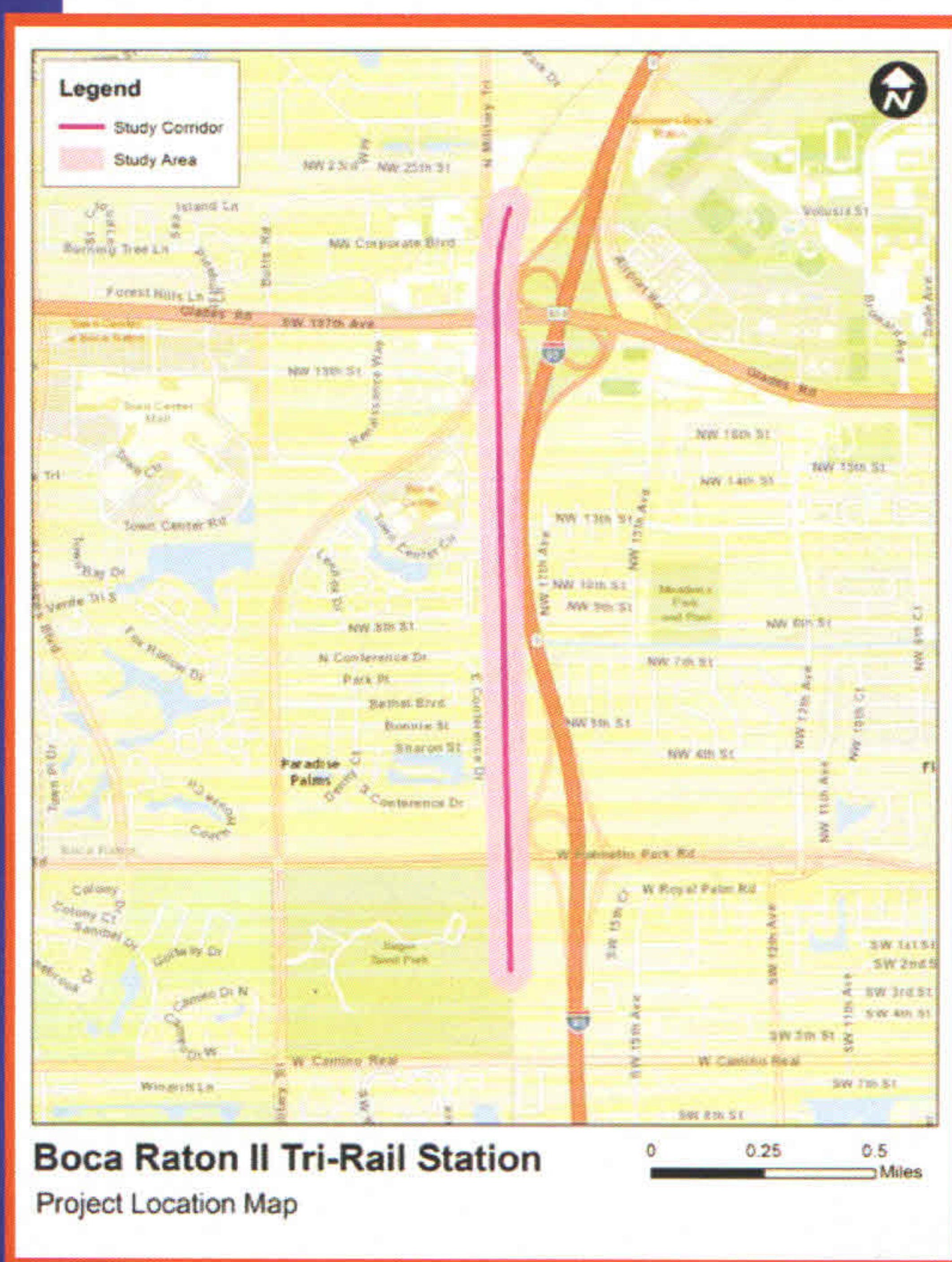
