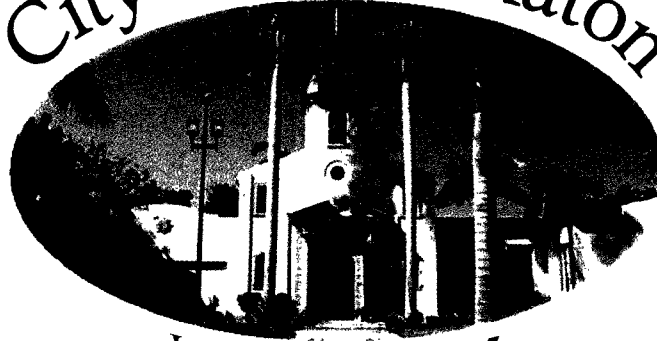

13 WHEREAS, Section 9-60, Code of Ordinances, authorizes the issuance of citations
14 by code enforcement officers directly to individuals for violations of certain provisions of the
15 Code of Ordinances expressly set forth in Section 9-60(2), Code of Ordinances; and

16 WHEREAS, Section 9-60(6)(d), Code of Ordinances, provides that the minimum civil
17 penalties for violations of the Code of Ordinances enforced pursuant to Section 9-60, Code of
18 Ordinances, shall be established by the City Council by resolution; now therefore
